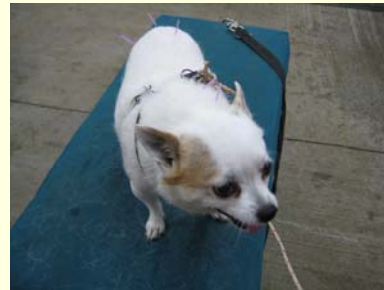
Chiropractic Care
