- Get your hands on them to check weight, hair and blankets can hide ribs!
- Keep barns ventilated. Don't shut them up just because it's cold. Horses are much more tolerant to cold weather than we are.
- Pick out the ice balls on your horses' feet so they don't slip.

Disease Watch

We have seen several equine of respiratory disease cases this fall. The most common cases have been influenza, rhinopneumonitis and strangles. These diseases are contagious and symptoms can include nasal discharge, cough and fever. If your horse exhibits any of these symptoms please call the office.
